



As an Integrated Care Board (ICB) we also take responsibility for Primary Medical Services (GPs) from 1 July 2022 and for dental, optometry and pharmacy, and some specialised services from April 2023. We were established on 1 July 2022 when the Black Country and West Birmingham Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) was abolished.

We are part of the Black Country Integrated Care System (ICS), known as Healthier Futures, working to bring health and social care services closer together for the good of our communities. You can find out more about the ICS and our collective priorities by visiting the Black Country ICS website.
